- Be referred by a WorkBC Centre
- Currently receiving Employment Insurance (EI) benefits
- Or have had an El claim in the last 5 years
- Or earned more than \$2,000 in insurable earnings and paid employee EI premiums on those earnings in at least 5 of the last 10 years
- Or BCEA PWD Clients or BCEA Non-PWD Clients (Income Insurance)
- High School graduate and meet College English Language Profiency Assessment Test provided by Western Community
