

PROGRAM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Program Admission Requirements

Applicants will be required to meet the following minimum criteria:

19 years of age, or older.

The student must have a **Bachelor's Degree**. The student must successfully complete the English Assessment Test at the college

In addition, International students need to have either of the following:

- IELTS Score 5.5 bands or above
- CLB Test Score Level 7
- College English Language Assessment Test with at least 60% marks


