HEALTH CARE ASSISTANT - ACUTE CARE TRAINING

Program starts on April 13, 2026

This dual credential FREE specialized training program is designed for students who want to be certified to work as a Health Care Assistant (HCA) with specialized training in Acute Care. HCAs provide professional care and supervision in protective and supportive health care environments, for clients/residents who have complex health challenges.

Program Eligibility Requirements:

- Resident of BC
- Canadian Citizens
- Permanent Residents
- Convention Refugees and legally entitled to work in Canada

AND open to currently unemployed or underemployed participants with some experience in the sector.

- Grade 12 or 19 years of age or above AND
- Proof of English Language Proficiency*
 - *Proof of at least 3 years of full-time secondary or post-secondary education in English, including English 10 or higher (minimum grade of C); or
 - *CLBPT, CELPIP, IELTS, CAEL, TOEFEL
- Health Declaration
